Integrity

The scripture this week invites us to examine our lives and to see if there is any inconsistency between what we say and believe and in how we behave.

Here Jesus is warning about religious hypocrites, and he is also warning us about becoming hypocrites ourselves. It is all about motives.

Appearances can be deceiving, motives can be hidden, but God sees our hearts.

The Bible is full of references to integrity, character, and moral purity.

A person of integrity will be honest, trustworthy, kind, authentic, and have strong moral principles.

Their behaviour will reflect their integrity. They will be truthful, will have a good reputation and not have to fear that he or she will be exposed or found out.

A person of integrity is the same person in private as he or she is in public. Their words and actions will match. What they say and how they live will be the same.

Scripture tells us that what we say, and what we do are to be in sync. If we say we love God, then we will need to demonstrate that love by the way we live.

As followers of Christ, our lives are to be distinguished by love and integrity. Our actions are to be consistent with our faith. We need to live for Christ, even when no one is looking.

So, are we living with integrity before God?
